RE: Nurse Prescribing

To whom it may concern,

Poland has joined the EU in 2004. Ten years after this important historical EU accession, the nursing profession in Poland has made enormous progress in complying with EU legislation and more importantly, transposing EU innovative practices into the daily reality of patients and citizens.

Therefore, the EFN takes this opportunity to congratulate the Polish main and regional Nurses and Midwives Chambers for their leadership in designing Polish nursing legislation on several topics which will benefit patient outcomes. Not only the nursing language ICNP®, on which Poland is leading internationally, contributes to the development of continuity of care, equally important is the design and implementation of nurse prescribing to contribute to a cost effective healthcare system. In many EU Member States, nurse prescribing is a fact and show positive impact on patient outcomes as nurses have now the opportunity to use their knowledge, skills and competencies at their full potential to empower patients within their everyday practice.
